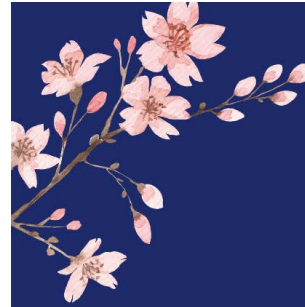

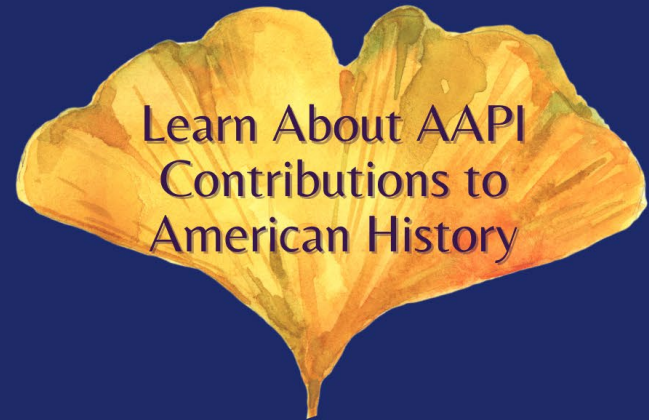
There are 48 different countries in Asia including Yemen, Saudi Arabia, Iran and Turkey. All under the classification of Asian Americans in the US.
